- possess diplomatic and political skills, including capacity to work strategically
- overall interest and enthusiasm for serving on the board, with a minimum time commitment to enable participation in six conference calls, one Annual General Meeting and committee work (a passion for the cause)
- ability to support fundraising activities
- ability to read and comprehend financial reports as presented by the finance committee / treasurer.
